Start the process

You should complete the Application for Defined Benefit Retirement 45 – 90 days before your desired retirement date. You can apply online through your myMERS account and we'll begin processing your information.

Choose your retirement payment option

The benefit calculation MERS sends you will show you what your monthly benefit would be for each option based on your beneficiary on file. Remember, regardless of how you choose to receive your benefit, it is promised to you for your lifetime. Receive your benefits

Once we've received all your application and required documentation, you'll begin receiving payments direct-deposited on the 18th of each month into the bank account you provided. Your payment will be based on your preliminary calculation that was sent to you and your selected payment option.
